## Ref: Attendance Home Visits

As part of our attendance procedures, please be aware that we regularly visit families of children who are not attending school, even if we have received a phone call. These visits are often unannounced.

There are many reasons why a home visit may be conducted. Some of the reasons are:

- When all other means to contact a family has failed.
- If a child has been absent from school for longer than expected.
- If a child has been off school for a period of time, for example due to a medical issue, so that they do
  not feel isolated from school.
- If a child is classed as persistently absent or severely absent.
- To try and establish that a child is safe if they are absent from school and attempts to contact
  parents or carers have not elicited a response and we have any welfare or safeguarding concerns for
  the student.
- To investigate situations when there are suspicions that someone may be on holiday contrary to earlier
  indications (for example when a child is not at school and reported as being ill, during the same period
  for which a request for exceptional leave in term-time had been refused).

This list is not exhaustive.

We are keen to develop understanding and strengthen relationships with parents/carers. Due to home visits, in some circumstances, we can offer early help support.

If you have any questions regarding home visits, please do make contact with the School Office.
