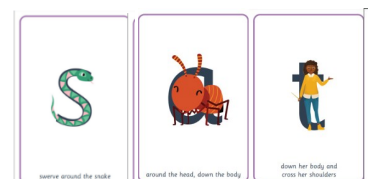
## Literacy Focus

From next week, we will begin a new book, Sharing a Shell. This will link to our geography theme on comparing where we live to the seaside. The children will complete activities based on the book such as researching about sea creatures, painting their favourite sea creature, talking about sharing, exploring colour and patterns and describing the characters using different adjectives. We will also discuss the beginning, middle and end of the story and sequence these to retell the story.

## Phonics Focus

Nursery 1— The children will continue to listen to initial sounds of different objects and play games of matching sounds.

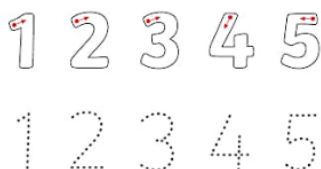
Nursery 2—We have now finished all the initial sounds that we cover in Nursery. We will begin to review all sounds and practice segmenting CVC (3 letter words) words in preparation for joining Reception, for example s-a-t =sat.



## Maths Focus

In maths, we will be focusing on Numbers 1-5. The children will explore numbers by representing them in different ways. We will cover number recognition and have a go at forming numbers. The children will count out different objects and recognise quantities by sight.
