Literacy Focus

In January, we will be focusing on nursery rhymes. The children will learn Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear, Turn around, Humpty Dumpty, Miss Polly had a Dolly, Old Macdonald had a Farm plus other favourites. We will look at rhyme and find pairs of rhyming words. The children will act out the rhymes, draw or paint their favourite nursery rhyme and put their own rhythm to the rhyme using different instruments.

Phonics Focus

Nursery 1—We will play listening games with more complex sounds.

Nursery 2—We will focus on hearing and saying the letter sounds 'o' and 'c,k,ck'. With the 'c' sound, we will explain that although it is the same sound there are three different ways of writing them. We will play listening games and sort objects into the correct letter sounds. We will find objects in the environment that begin with these sounds and we will have a go at making these letter sounds in the sand, with playdough and with loose parts.









Maths Focus

Our next focus in maths will be looking at counting Rhymes which will also link to our literacy focus. The children will learn 5 Red Apples, Old Macdonald, 5 Little Speckled Frogs and 10 Green Bottles. We will count the apples on the tree, the animals in the farm, the Frogs in the Pond and the Bottles on the Wall showing awareness of counting and number names.


Miss Polly had a dolly

And he knocked at the door, with a rat-a-tat-tat.


He looked at the dolly and he shook his head.
