Talking Tubs

In your child's book bag you will find a 'Talking Tub'. Over the holiday, please collect some small objects that represent some of the things that you have done. For example, a cinema ticket, a shell, a leaf or a pebble. In class, we will look at them together and recount what they have done on their holiday. Have fun collecting your objects!

Literacy Focus

After half term, we will continue our theme of vegetables and we will be reading 'The Enormous Turnip'.

The children will complete different activities based on this book such as sequencing the story, investigating where turnips come from, use our senses to find out what they look like, what they smell like, what they feel like and what they taste like! The children will also explore pushing and pulling and size linked to the book. We will have a go at making observational drawings of turnips and we will complete some vegetable printing.

Phonics Focus

Nursery 1—We will explore alliteration by saying the initial sound of our names and try and think of a descriptive word with the same initial sound such as 'Silly Sarah'.

Nursery 2—We will focus on hearing and saying the letter sounds 'p' and 'i'. We will play listening games and sort objects into the correct letter sounds. We will find objects in the environment that begin with these sounds and we will have a go at making these letter sounds in the sand.




Maths Focus

After half term, our focus in maths will be on measure. We will begin to explore weight linked to our focus book in literacy, 'The Enormous Turnip'. The children will compare different weights of objects and vegetables. We will also look at size and place objects in order according to size. The children will begin to use comparative language such as heavy, heavier, heaviest, big, bigger, and biggest.
