Nursery Christmas Singalong!

We are now starting to practice our Christmas Songs and we are looking forward to welcoming you to our Christmas Singalong on Monday 8th December. Please refer to the letter sent previously for more details. We will be putting videos of the songs onto Tapestry so that you can learn the songs with your child.

Literacy Focus

Next week, we will begin reading our new book, 'Rosie's Walk'. The children will sequence the story by creating a map of where Rosie went and they will be acting out the story with role-play masks and props. We will also find out facts about chickens and cockerels and discuss what they eat and where they live. The children will explore using the iPads to draw a picture of the fox from the story using a program on the iPad called Paint.

Phonics Focus

Nursery 1—We will explore rhyme by listening to Nursery rhymes and play rhyming games such as finding the rhyme pair such as cat and hat.

Nursery 2—We will focus on hearing and saying the letter sounds 'n' and 'm'. We will play listening games and sort objects into the correct letter sounds. We will find objects in the environment that begin with these sounds and we will have a go at making these letter sounds in the sand, with playdough and with loose parts.




Maths Focus

Our next theme in maths will be spatial awareness which is linked to our new book, 'Rosie's Walk'. We will follow Rosie on her walk and play prepositional games. The children will follow instructions around the Nursery playground, for example: **up** the steps, **down** the slide, **through** the gate, **under** the castle.








Rosie's Walk Vocabulary
