Week beginning 11.03.19

Over the next two weeks, we are focusing on developing our enquiry skills through exploring and investigating trees. The children have thought of a selection of questions that they would like to explore and investigate. The question we are focusing on over the next two weeks is:

‘Which fruits grow on trees?’

So we are focusing on distinguishing between fruits and vegetables and then looking into the different fruits that grow on trees.

Literacy Focus:

In our literacy focus tasks we will be following the children’s enquiries through a variety of different activities encouraging mark making, application of phonics as well as asking and answering questions.

Phonics Focus: (Differentiated for key groups)

We will be focusing on the following phonemes where we will be practising to read, write and apply within our play.

Mathematics Focus:

In our number sessions, we are investigating different ways to separate a number of objects and then moving into addition, combining two groups of objects to find a total.

Gemma’s and Kerry’s Focus groups will be continuing to develop their counting skills and number recognition. .
