Literacy Focus

Next week, our focus in Literacy will be The Gingerbread Man. We have already started singing a gingerbread man song in our music lessons and the children are doing a great job learning the words. During this topic, we will be acting out the story, sequencing the story and making our very own gingerbread man. To link to this we will paint different characters from the story and use the small world characters to retell the story.

Phonics Focus

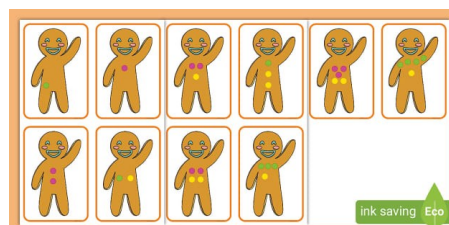
Nursery 1— The children will play listening games and clap out their names focusing on the first sound.

Nursery 2—We will focus on hearing and saying the initial sound 'y' and the end sound 'x'. We will play listening games and sort objects into the correct letter sounds. We will find words and objects in the environment that begin with the sounds 'y' and words that end with 'x'. We will also use our robot arms to sound out words such as 'yak', 'yet', 'box' and 'fix'.



Maths Focus

In maths, we will be focusing on number. In Nursery 1, the children will be exploring the number 3. They will count out objects to 3, recognise 3 items by sight and investigate how 3 is made up e.g. 1 and 2. In Nursery 2, the children will be exploring the number 5 and will be focusing on how we make 5 e.g. 2 and 3, 1 and 4. We will link our activities to The Gingerbread Man story.



Concept Cat



Concept Cat is a fun, child-friendly character we use in Nursery to help children learn early concepts through play. Concept Cat helps to introduce concepts such as weight, sizes light and dark and routines in a simple, engaging way. By using stories, songs, games and short activities with Concept Cat, children build confidence, language and understanding while learning together. It supports learning in a gentle, enjoyable way that is suitable for young children and helps make key concepts easy to remember.

You may have heard your child come home and tell you about the new concept we are learning. You will find this information on our notice board at Nursery which includes which concept we are learning that week and an activity that you can do at home to consolidate this new concept. You could even introduce a concept cat at home!
