Wrekin Forest School Trip—Tuesday 9th June

Literacy Focus

After half term we will move onto our next book, Jasper's Beanstalk. The children will learn about growing through this story and we will start to plant our own seeds. We will discuss the lifecycle of a plant and keep a diary of our own seed growing. The children will also make some observational drawings and paintings of plants and use our senses to smell and taste some herbs growing in our garden.

Phonics Focus

Nursery 1— The children will listen to initial sounds of different objects and play games of matching sounds.

Nursery 2—We will focus on hearing and saying the initial sound 'z' and the end sound 'zz'. We will play listening games and sort objects into the correct letter sounds. We will find words and objects in the environment that begin with the sounds 'z' and end with 'zz'. We will also use our robot arms to sound out words such as 'zoom', 'zoo', 'zig-zag' and 'buzz'.



Maths Focus

In maths, we will be focusing measure. The children will explore capacity, height and length linking to growing. We will measure how tall the children are and measure objects around the environment. The children will use comparative language such tall, taller, tallest. To begin with we will be using non-standard units such as multilink or footprints to measure and then, move on to rulers or tape measures. The children will also investigate capacity when filling plant pots and using different sized containers in the water tray. For this the children will use full and empty to describe their container.



Viral Trend Risks Causing Severe Burns to Children
