## Sun Hats and Sun Cream

Sun Hats and Sun Cream As the weather begins to warm up, please ensure that children come to school with a named sun hat and have sun cream applied before they arrive. If you would like your child to reapply sun cream during the day, please send in a clearly labelled bottle that they can use themselves. If they find this difficult, you might want to consider using longer-lasting sun creams that can be applied by you before they come to school. Children are not allowed to share sun cream.

## Literacy Focus

In Literacy we have started our new topic on Toys. The children will look at non-fiction books about the History of Toys and we will sort and compare old and new toys thinking about what they are made from and how they work. Show and Tell will link to this topic where the children can talk about their own toys from home. We will also be reading a fiction book called 'Lost in the Toy Museum' where we will make predictions about what might happen next, play the games from the story and follow instructions and create our own Toy Museum making labels for our toys.

## Phonics Focus

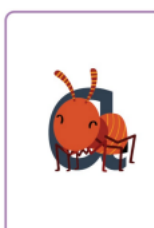
Nursery 2 we will be focusing on the letter sound 'z' and we will then begin to review all of our letter sounds so far starting with 's-a-t'. The children will be identifying objects that begin with the sound 'z' and find the sound in books using the magnifying glasses. They will be segmenting and blending words such as zip, zap, zig-zag.

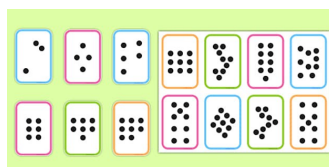
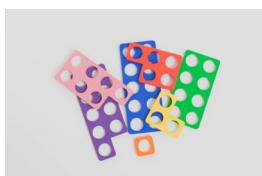

In Nursery 1 we will use the mirrors to say our own names looking at how we pronounce the sounds. We will listen for the first sound of our names and think of other words beginning with that sound.

## Maths Focus

In Maths we are focusing on Counting and Number. The children will be counting out different objects and then represent that number they have counted. This could be by using their fingers, the numicon, dots, number cards, number lines or even writing the numeral. The children will count out the number of objects and say how many they have got. We will link this objective to counting Toys around the classroom.
