Stay and Play

We would like to start our 'Stay and Play' sessions after the holiday. These sessions which will take place every 2 weeks and are an opportunity for you to come and play with your child and have a look at what they are learning. These sessions will be at drop off from 9.00—9.15 on Tuesdays and Fridays from the 28th April.

Literacy Focus

In Literacy we have started our new topic on Trees. We will be transferring our knowledge and skills from the lifecycle of a frog to the lifecycle of a tree. We will gather information from non-fiction books on trees and use this information to learn about what grows on tress and how they grow. This will lead onto learning about different fruits and we will explore what is inside an apple, an orange and other fruits. We will also talk about the lifecycle of a tree using the appropriate vocabulary. The children will also have a go at drawing trees using different tools such as a pencil, charcoal or crayons.

Phonics Focus

Nursery 2 we will be focusing on the sounds 'x' and 'y'. The children will be identifying objects that begin with these sounds and find these sounds in the environment. They will be segmenting and blending words such as box, fox, six, yes, yum and yell. We will also practice forming them using sand, chalks and other mark making tools.

In Nursery 1 we will go on a sound walk and listen for different sounds in the environment and then have a go at drawing

Maths Focus

In Maths we are focusing on Number. In Nursery 1 we will be reviewing the number 1 and exploring the number 2. In Nursery 2 we will be reviewing the number 3 and exploring the number 4. We will complete different activities through the 4 c's.

- 1. Counting—how many trees we can you see?
- Cardinality— can you represent the number in different ways? 2.
- 3. Composition— can you find 2 apples?
- 4. Comparison— who has more?
