#### **Books**

#### **Literacy Focus**

In literacy, we will continue with our topic on 'Bears' by reading other bear stories such as 'We're going on a bear hunt' and 'Barnaby Bear goes to the seaside'. Linked to this we will compare places and identify the different features of a town and the seaside. This will also link to Geography. We will be looking at Telford and Barmouth and find similarities and differences of the two places. The children are also looking forward to our own teddy bears picnic which will take place on Wednesday 9th July during our Welly Walk. The children will be able to bring their own teddy bear from home on that day to take to the picnic. We will also be following instructions to play games.

#### **Phonics Focus**

Nursery 2: We will continue to review all of our letter sounds and we will focus on 'e-u-r' over the next 2 weeks. The children will be identifying objects that begin with the sound and we will be sounding out 3 letter words using our robot arms, such as ten, peg, up, run. We will complete different activities based on these sounds such as a sound hunt, letter skittles and I spy. We will also have a go at forming the letters in sand and shaving foam using the rhymes. The children will also practice writing their names.




Nursery 1: We will play the game 'What's in the box?'. The children will take turns to pull out objects from the box, name the object and say the first sound they can hear, such as 'c..c..car'. Once all the objects are out we will play a memory game where the children will have to guess which object is missing.


### **Maths Focus**

In maths, we will continue to sing number rhymes and use our fingers or other ways to represent the numbers. The children will explore the numbers 1,2,3,4,5. They will play games where they have to hunt for different quantities of objects such as ' find 3 leaves, find 4 stones, find 5 bears'. We will also look at number formation and write the numerals using the rhymes.
