Literacy Focus

In Literacy, we have started our new topic on 'Sunflowers'. We will look at non-fiction books and the internet to find out information about growing sunflowers. The children will learn about the lifecycle of a plant. They will plant their own sunflower and monitor its growth over the coming weeks by creating a diary. To link to this topic we will draw and paint sunflowers using different media and learn about how to care for our environment.

Phonics Focus

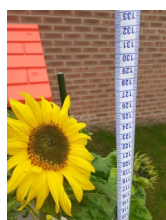
Nursery 2: We will continue to review all of our letter sounds and we will focus on 'm-d-g' over the next 2 weeks. The children will be identifying objects that begin with the sound and we will be sounding out 3 letter words using our robot arms such as mat, dog, got. We will complete different activities based on these sounds such as a sound hunt, letter skittles and I spy. We will also have a go at forming the letters in sand and shaving foam using the rhymes.



Nursery 1: We will say the first sound of our names and match objects with the same sound. We will also use the mirrors to say the sounds observing our mouths for pronunciation.

Maths Focus

In maths, we will be looking at Measure. Over the next few weeks as our sunflowers grow we will be measuring their height using non-standard units such as cubes or blocks then we will move on to using rulers and tape measures. The children will also measure other objects using these methods and record heights or lengths. Linked to measure the children will also explore capacity and will fill containers in the water tray using vocabulary such as 'full' and 'empty'.





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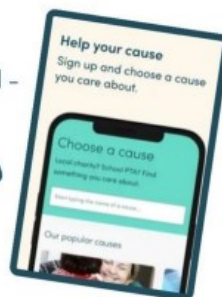
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Welly Walk

The children love playing amongst the bushes and trees completing different activities, therefore it is important that they are dressed appropriately for these activities. As a result, we just wanted to remind you that when we go on Welly Walk the children need to come dressed wearing their waterproof suit or trousers with an appropriate jacket. If the weather is warm on that day their legs and arms still need to be covered with either tights, leggings or trousers and their cardigan or jumper.
