Re: School Uniform

It is the expectation that all children attending Redhill Primary Academy should wear the school uniform as detailed below, without variation.

Boys

A grey sweatshirt or cardigan and a jade polo shirt each with the **school logo**.

Plain **grey** trousers or knee length shorts in the summer (not black) – no leggings.

Grey socks (not black).

Black school shoes, no trainers or boots.

Hair - extreme cuts (under Grade 2) are not allowed. This includes cut patterns, tram lines or designs in the hair.

Girls

A grey sweatshirt or cardigan and a jade polo shirt each with the **school logo**.

Plain **grey** knee-length skirt or pinafore, trousers optional, no leggings (**no items of black**).

Grey tights or knee high socks.

Black school shoes – no slip on shoes, boots, open-toed sandals or heels. Heels/open-toed sandals/slip on shoes are not suitable for children running around on the playground. Without appropriate footwear, children will only access indoor play. Boots can be worn to school, but children must change into their school shoes on arrival.

A green knee-length checked dress/skort dress or knee length shorts may be worn in summer with white ankle or knee high socks.

School shoes must still be worn in the summer.

All long hair must be kept securely tied back to support the wellbeing of children, to help reduce the transmission of headlice. Hair accessories must be **minimal in design** and also in the school colour of green, grey or black.

Make up, including nail varnish, is not allowed.

PE Kit

There is a limited number of PE t-shirts which can be purchased from school via ParentPay. Please do not place an order for a PE t-shirt that is not in stock, as we will be unable to provide it. Once our current PE stock is depleted, PE t-shirts will be available to purchase from Baker and Son. Both types of PE t-shirts will be acceptable for the children to wear.

Black shorts (for indoor PE).

Plain, black, warm jogging trousers/tracksuit (for outdoor PE).

School logo black hoodie or plain black fleece hoodie, no tracksuit logo tops.

Please note children will need some form of sweatshirt/hoodie, coats are not suitable for outdoor PE. Trainers can be worn, no pumps required. Please ensure that all articles of clothing and footwear are clearly marked with your child's name.

Children will not be able to participate in PE without the correct PE kit. In accordance with Health and Safety Regulations, we have requested that children do not wear earrings or any jewellery for PE lessons or swimming. If your child is unable to remove their earrings themselves at school, then please can you ensure that they are not worn to school on the days that they have PE or swimming. If your child has newly pierced ears, please supply micro-pore tape for them to keep in their bag, so that they can cover their earrings during PE. This is to prevent any accidents occurring which could cause considerable discomfort to your child and we would ask for your co-operation in this matter. If earrings are worn to school, only small studs are appropriate.

School Bags

Green reading book bags. If your child is adding a keyring to the bag for easy identification, this needs to be minimal in size, as the bags need to fit in the children's drawer.

Drawstring green bags for PE kits. These only need to be brought in on days the children have a club as children are allowed to wear PE kits on the days they have PE.

Our uniform suppliers Baker and Son are based in Wellington, where school uniform is available to try on and buy. Baker and Son stock school **polo shirts, sweatshirts, cardigans, PE t-shirts and hoodies, book bags and drawstring PE bags**. There is also the option to order online at www.bakerandsonschoolwear.co.uk/product-category/your-school/redhill-primary. If you select delivery to school, please use the voucher code: redhill. Orders will be delivered to us on Thursdays. If you do choose for your order to be delivered to school, we cannot guarantee that orders can be distributed during the last week of term.
