The Marie Collins Foundation and The NWG Network have put together a short article which I'm sure many parents will find useful. Covered within the article are:

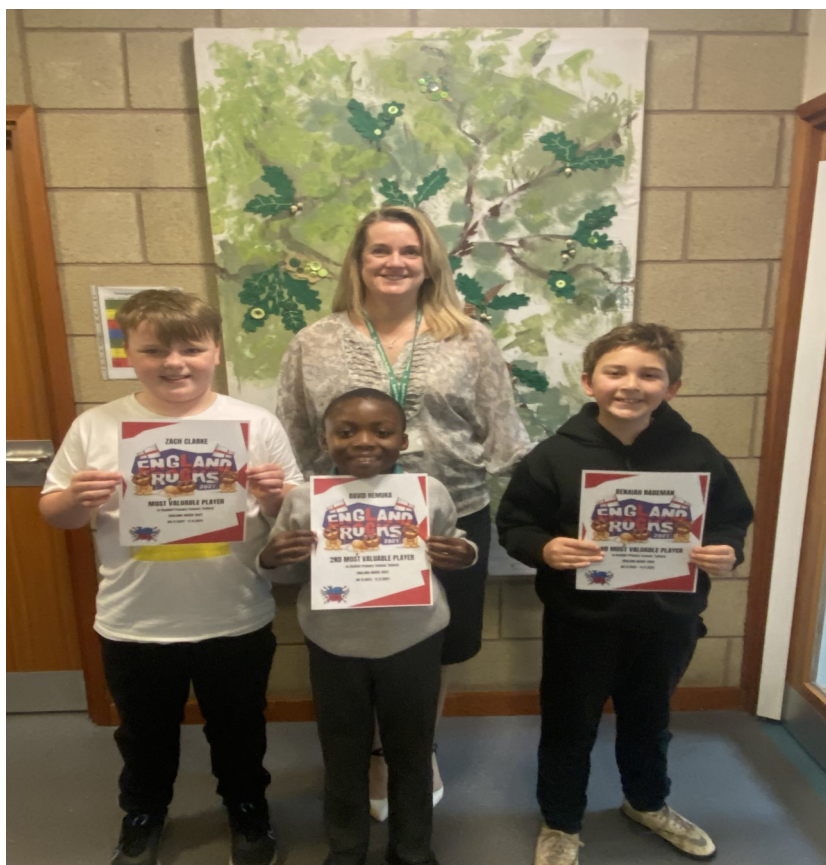
- What is online harm?
