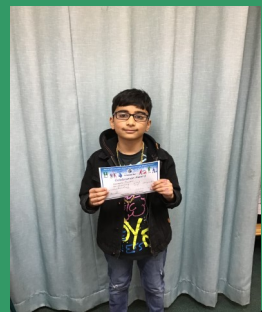
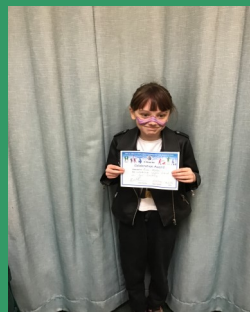
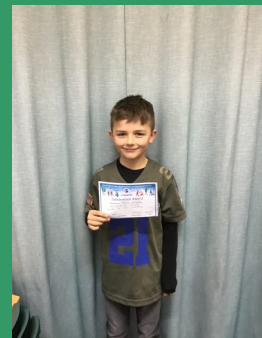
## Year 2 - Ironbridge Trip

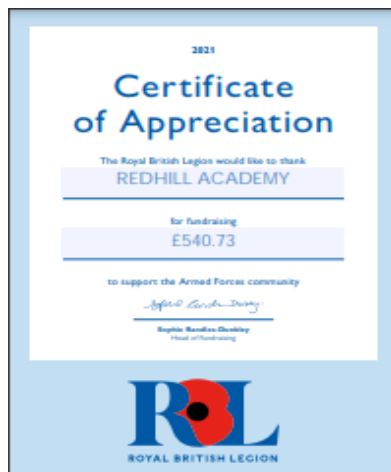

# Number Day 2022

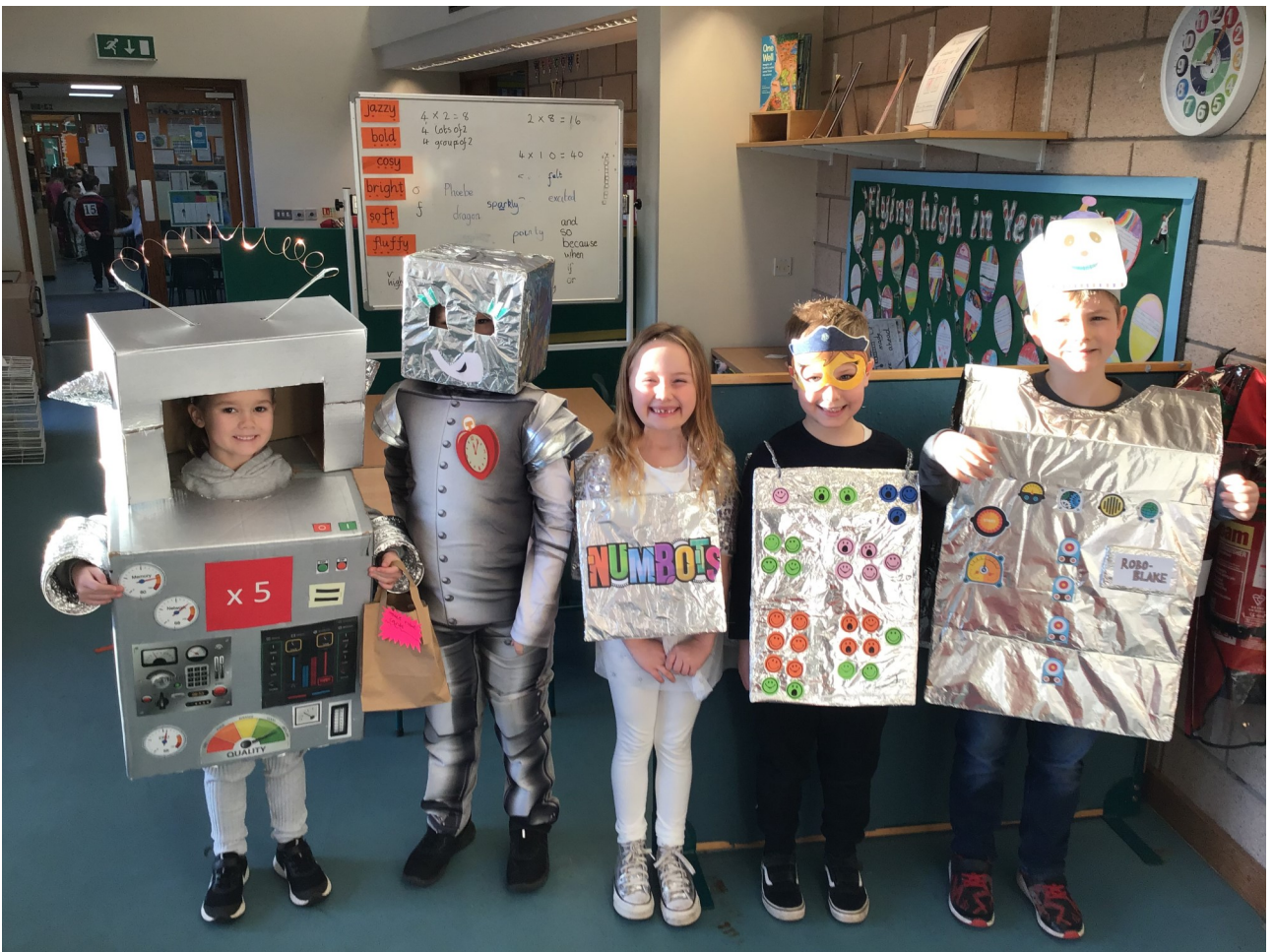
Today, we celebrated World Number Day and all things maths!
