Year 3 Shropshire Hills Discovery Centre

On Monday, the Year 3 children visited Shropshire Hills Discovery Centre to find out more about the Bronze Age and Iron Age.

We started off looking at the woolly mammoth skeleton from the last Ice Age before stepping forwards in time and looking at roundhouses and hill forts. We found out about what life would have been like during these times and what we would have been doing as children. The leaders also talked to us about the different hill forts that were in Shropshire and where we can still see evidence of them today.

During our activity time, we had the opportunity to have a go at creating a woven wattle and daub wall, firing a slingshot, painting our hands with celtic patterns and carding some wool.
