The children will be in zones on the school field and you will be able to move across to your different children. Please note that parking might be difficult, so please walk or car share where possible and also remember to bring your packed lunch and a blanket to sit on. Please avoid parking on the hairdressers/doctors' car park.

Sun Hats, Sun Cream and Water Bottles

Please remember to provide your child with a sun hat and labelled sun cream. Children are not allowed to share sun cream and have to apply it by themselves. If they find this difficult, it may be worth looking at the longer lasting sun creams that can be applied, by yourself, before your child comes to school.

Please ensure that all children bring their water bottles to school every day.

Scooters and Bikes

Please remember that all children should dismount from their scooters/bikes when entering the school grounds. If your child does arrive at school on a scooter/bike, please be vigilant of ensuring their safety and remind them to be considerate of other people when riding on footpaths or crossing roads.
