We hope you can help us with supporting this celebration and know that this will be a real treat for the children who have all worked very hard over the year. Year 6 children have their own special treat booked for this week. We hope that all children have fun!

Break Time Snacks

As a school, we promote the fruit scheme and encourage uptake of the Government funded fruit provided for all KS1 children. All KS1 classes will have a basket of fruit in class for easy access. There is no need to provide a snack for children in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 as they will be encouraged to eat the fruit provided. If you do provide one, please ensure it is healthy.

Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 children are encouraged to bring in a healthy snack or can have access to the school fruit.

Water

We provide routines for water bottles in the classroom, sending reminders home through the Mail on Friday at regular intervals which highlight the importance of access to water throughout the day.

We will provide water coolers for children to access fresh water. Water bottles will be sent home for cleaning. No drinks other than water will be brought into school by pupils unless recommended by a doctor for medical reasons.

At lunchtimes we encourage water (jugs and cups provided) and non-sparkling and low sugary drinks in lunchboxes.

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children are dropped off and collected via the small playground. Their KS2 siblings can also gain entry and be collected via the technology door on the small playground.

Mrs Fance's Year 3 children can enter via the small playground or the KS2 playground door.

Collection is from the KS2 playground door.

Ms Dhillon's Year 4 class can enter via the KS2 playground door or via their classroom doors.

Collection is from the KS2 playground door.

Mrs Richards' Year 3 children, Mrs Davies' Year 4 children, Year 5 and Year 6 children will all enter via their classroom doors or the KS2 playground door. Collection is from their classroom door. The KS2 playground door is accessed via the gate off the footpath running along the side of the school.

Child Saver tickets are valid for pupils up to and including year 11.

Student Saver tickets are available for anyone aged 16+ in full time education.

To ensure you get your ticket in time for the start of the new academic year, you can register now but set your payments to commence later in August. Once we have received your payment, a ticket will be sent to you, and you will not need to worry about paying on the bus every time.

You can choose to receive your pass by post or if you download the Arriva UK bus app onto your child's phone, we can send them an m-ticket.
