


## School Librarians

On Monday we came to school wearing odd socks to show our individuality and to celebrate that we are all different!





#### Year 5 Friendship Week







In our workshop today we have been focusing on bullying as part of friendship week. We started by talking about what bullying is: deliberately being unkind several times. We then talked about the different types of bullying: cyber, emotional, physical, social, verbal and how to deal with these issues. Following a game, we realised that bullying can make you feel unsafe, nervous, worried or even angry. We thought about how our expressions and our body language can show our emotions. We had a go at acting out different scenarios where bullying might be happening, including at home and at school, and talked about what changed. We thought about what a "power pose" would look like - how you could show you are confident and strong and not be bullied by others. We then worked in groups to create a scene showing bullying in different forms and how people could deal with the bullying in a better way. We used some given phrases to help us: be strong, walk away; I'm not going to put up with this; wrong is wrong, even if everyone is doing it.
