As you are already aware, applications are open for Year 6 children who are due to start secondary school in September 2024. The deadline for applying for secondary school places is 31st October 2023.

If you reside outside the Telford and Wrekin area, please apply to your home Local Authority. Parents can submit up to four preference schools on their application and we encourage parents to apply for more than one school as, if admissions are unable to offer your preferred school, you may be allocated a school that is some distance away if your catchment school is already full.

Each year, Telford and Wrekin do see a lot of applications that have only one preference which can lead to disappointment when allocated a school at some distance from home addresses.
