#### Safeguarding Resource for Parents / Carers

Young people are increasingly being groomed by online predators to create sexually explicit images and videos.

The Internet Watch Foundation (IWF) have created a campaign entitled, TALK and Gurls Out Loud 'Self-Generated' Child Sexual Abuse Prevention.

The campaign, backed by the UK Home Office, Microsoft, TikTok and supported by Snapchat and Twitter, aims to empower young people, and warn their parents and carers about the risks posed by online predators targeting children.

#### Year 3 - Visit from Shropshire Falconry Trust

On Monday, we were lucky enough to have a visit from Lisa from the Shropshire Falconry Trust. She came to school to tell us all about owls and birds of prey. This links in to our science topic on Animals and their Skeletons and our literacy reports on Barn Owls.

During the visit, Lisa told us all about the key adaptations of owls and how these adaptations helped them to effectively hunt for prey. Some of us were even lucky enough to wear the gloves and have one of the owls fly on to our hand.

One of the owls, Frodo, was a six month old baby barn owl who was very noisy and decided to swoop above us in the hall. We were very interested to discover that scientists think that the underside of the barn owl is white so that when they are swooping above their prey at night, the prey is deceived in to thinking it is a cloud above them and the prey does not try and escape.
