# Secondary School Admissions September 2022

The online app<mark>lication form for Year 6 children who are due to start secondary school in September 2022 is now open on the Telford and Wrekin school admissions website.</mark>

The closing date for all applications is 31st October 2021.

Please note: You must apply to the local authority of where you live, for example where you pay your council tax.

## Starting Reception in September 2022

The online application form for children who are due to start school in Reception 2022 is now available on the Telford and Wrekin school admissions website: <a href="www.telford.gov.uk/admissions">www.telford.gov.uk/admissions</a>
To apply for a Reception 2022 school place, parents will need to use the online system.

Please note:

- \* Parents will need to make an application to the Local Authority of where they are living e.g. where they pay council tax to.
- You must apply if your child was born between 1 September 2017 31 August 2018.
- \* You **must** apply even if your child is attending a nursery or pre-school on a school site or you have a child already attending the school.
- \* Attending a nursery does **not** guarantee a school place.
- \* If a child has an **Education, Health & Care Plan,** the **closing date** is **31 October 2021** for all applications.
- \* School places are allocated in line with oversubscription criteria.

The deadline for applying for a school place is 15 January 2022.

#### Free School Meals

Your child, or children, may qualify for Free School Meals if you meet the following criteria:

You or your partner (if you have one) have a child for whom you receive Child Benefit and who is

attending a school or college in Telford and Wrekin.

And you are in receipt of any of the following:

**Income Support** 

Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance

Income-related Employment and Support Allowance

Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)

support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

Pension Credit (guaranteed credit)

Universal Credit and your household income is less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get).

Each school receives a weekly register showing the names of all children who are entitled to Free School Meals.

Should your circumstances change, for example you start work, increase your working hours to more than 16 a week, or cease being entitled to Income Support or Jobseeker's Allowance, you must notify Telford and Wrekin Council immediately.

Each school has the right to ask you to repay the value of any school meals that your child has been given for free, if they were not entitled to those meals.

If your child is eligible for Free School Meals, they'll remain eligible until they finish the current phase of schooling (primary or secondary) they're in on 31 March 2022.

# Celebration Assemblies

Here at Redhill, we ensure that children's efforts and hard work are rewarded.
