Sarah said, "It's been an exciting time and I hope that I've helped just a little to put Redhill Primary and our PTA on the map.

"We've hit the news on numerous occasions, including the printed press, local radio and TV news and our social media accounts have gone from approx. 50 followers to over 800. Our fundraising efforts have been featured as case studies for PTAs across the country and we've even received a personal message from Hollywood stars, but the time has come to hand over the PR reins to someone else now.

"I've used my 'day job skills' for the last 16 years on a voluntary basis to help raise the profile of charities and associations, lobby for funding and helped to raise over £160K in that time, and now as my twins prepare to leave Redhill, and with a very busy full-time job, it's time for someone else to work their PR magic."
