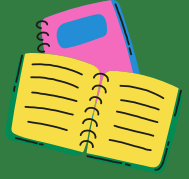

Crucial Crew – 22nd June 2026

On Monday, our Year 6 pupils visited Crucial Crew at Telford College, where they took part in a carousel of activities designed to promote safe and responsible behaviour. The children explored a range of important topics, including water safety and how to carry out a safe rescue, the dangers of vaping, and the effects of alcohol through the use of “beer goggles.” They also attended workshops on the risks of trusting strangers, how children may be tricked into looking after suspicious packages, and the hazards associated with electricity.

Despite the very hot weather, the children were outstanding representatives of Redhill. They asked thoughtful questions, engaged fully in the activities, and conducted themselves with respect throughout the demonstrations.

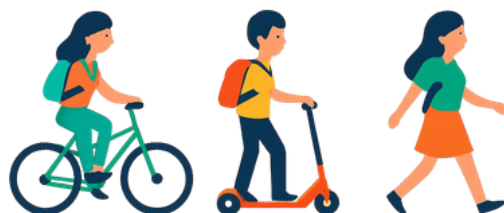
- Taking part is your choice.
