- visit the academy occasionally throughout the year
- complete some background reading, particularly to prepare for meetings
- take part in induction training and ongoing development

- the opportunity to work with our team of governors and staff in improving the academy
- a sense of achievement in making a difference to the academy
- the pleasure of helping pupils reach their potential
