Mrs Fance's Class Visit to University of Derby

As part of our Careers and Aspirations Week, we have organised a visit to the University of Derby, Kedleston Road, Derby, DE22 1GB. The visit will take place on **Wednesday 25th May 2022**.

Staff and children will leave school at 8.15am, so children will need to arrive no later than 8am via the main school door. We will return at around 3.50pm dependent on traffic. If children do not have consent to walk home/to meet a parent offsite, they will need to be picked up at this later time from the small playground opposite the school car park.

Whilst at the university, children will learn all about degree-level education and life at university. They will have the chance to meet some student ambassadors and will be given a tour of the campus.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch and non-fizzy drinks for the day.
