Dear Parents and Carers of Year 2 Children

In the autumn term, the children will begin a topic called 'fantastic bridges'. Throughout the topic, the children will explore and develop an understanding of the locations of some of the United Kingdom's most fantastic bridges. The project will allow the children to develop geographical skills and also develop their knowledge.
