Dear Parents and Carers

As part of our work on 'Changes' from the Stone Age, the Year 3 children will be visiting Shropshire Hills Discovery Centre. This will provide the children an opportunity to experience what life was like through hands-on activities, a tour around the replica roundhouse and a guided walk up to a local hill fort. The children will visit on Monday 30th March 2020 and will leave school at approximately 9am and will leave Craven Arms at 2.30pm. We expect them to arrive back to school at 3.15pm (traffic permitting).

The organisers advise that for full enjoyments of the activities, it is vital that the children wear old clothes which they can get dirty with long trousers to enable them to move safely through the woods. Shorts and sandals are not suitable. We ask that they wear their school polo shirts and jumpers together with a waterproof coat and suitable footwear. Wellies or old trainers are recommended, brought in a named bag. It is very important to bring a change of shoes as the children will get muddy. Depending on the weather it may also be advisable to apply sun screen on your child before the trip, as a lot of the day is spent outside. Hayfever/travel sickness sufferers will need to take their medication before the trip. If your child has allergic reactions to face paints/lanolin in wool, please let us know.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch and non-fizzy drinks for the day. If your child would like to order a school packed lunch please confirm this on ParentPay and provide a bag to carry their lunch in.

The cost of the trip to include the coach and entrance/workshops will be £11.00 per child. As you know we can only ask for voluntary contributions towards the cost and no child will be treated differently if they do not pay, however the visit can only go ahead if there is a sufficient level of voluntary contributions.
